The largest and deepest ocean basin in the world is the Pacific Ocean. The Pacific Ocean basin is by far the largest in the world, covering around 63 million square miles and holding more than half of the planet's free water.

About 97 percent of the water on Earth is in the ocean; the other 3 percent is in glaciers and ice, underground in rivers and lakes. Approximately 97 percent of the 332 million cubic miles of water that make up the world's entire water supply are located in the ocean.

More than 70% of the surface of our globe is covered by the water. It's difficult to believe, yet our oceans contain nearly 97 percent of the water on Earth.

Thus, option A is correct.
